Priorities

The 2004 AAAGP Annual General Meeting was held on 2 October at the RACGP National Annual Scientific Convention in Melbourne. A number of issues were discussed and priorities established for 2004/5. These priorities included:

- to continue very active lobbying for the continuation of the PHCRED program
- to establish a working group, under the leadership of Prof Dimity Pond to map and define what should be the ideal undergraduate general practice exposure for all medical students across Australia to further develop a secretariat to support the AAAGP work.
- to expand the AAAGP executive to include Prof Nick Glasgow from APHRI and A/Prof Steve Trumble, as the GPET link.
- to fine tune the AAAGP Constitution to cope with the growth of the organisation.
- to look at our current fee structure and ascertain if this is appropriate for the current organisation.
- to continue building partnerships with such groups as the NHMRC.
