Activities and achievements over last 12 months (dot points)	 Continued efforts through discussions with MRFF and RACGP to lobby for funding for national practice based research networks AAAPC supported an application led by University of Melbourne with 11 other departments of general practice to the MRFF National Critical Research Infrastructure grant scheme to fund a national practice based research network (unsuccessful). Submission to consultation on future model of alignment of NHMRC and MRFF Potential responses to AAAPC lobbying over last 2 years to MRFF starting to be observed through specific primary care streams within MRFF calls beyond the single primary care annual call. Attempts to increase engagement with New Zealand and identify roles for AAAPC in supporting lobbying.
