View All Sessions: Click this link to go to the Sessions page.

Community: See the delegate list and message attendees.

Sessions: Clicking the name of the session will take you to the session page to view speakers and a session description.

Add/remove sessions: You are able to add/remove sessions from your schedule by clicking on the 'Add' pills that appear on this page.

Expo: Visit the exhibition and poster display.

Click on your initials to update your **profile**.

Click on the **message** icon to send a message and start a chat with another attendee.

Click on the calendar icon to view sessions you have added to your **schedule**.

"Live" pill: On the day an orange 'Live' pill will appear, drawing your attention to the sessions on at the current time.

Join session: If a session is live, you can click Join Session and you will be taken to a new Zoom window to view the session.
