In this talk I will share a little of my career journey and how I inadvertently morphed into an academic. My subsequent research interests and methodologies have been eclectic, which fits well with also being a generalist clinician.

Over the past few years I have moved toward a co-design approach to research, and I will share some stories about projects involving Pacific people in South Auckland, Māori youth in Northland, and primary care researchers in low- and middle-income countries.

Felicity Goodyear-Smith is Professor and Goodfellow Postgraduate Chair in the Department of General Practice & Primary

Health Care, Faculty of Medical & Health Science at the University of Auckland. She was Head of the Department from 2013 to 2019. She is a general practitioner and also founding Editor of the Journal for Primary Health Care.
